

Allied Arts Fund Quality of Life Program explanation:

- Every donor who donates \$1500 to the Allied Arts Fund (AAF) qualifies for two season tickets (or other comparable perk) from each of our member arts agencies. For every additional \$1500 given, the donor is entitled to another two tickets etc.

The following options are available to the donor in regards to tickets.

- Each Quality of Life donor can choose which tickets they wish to receive.
- They can choose to take all the tickets from all the AAF member arts agencies that they're entitled to, or only specific tickets from specific agencies. (Quality of Life donors can only take as many tickets from a member agency as they are entitled to, based on the total value of the gift. The donor could not choose to take \$800 worth of Symphony tickets in return for their \$1500 gift.)
- Or the giver can choose to take the entire value of the charitable gift and receive none of the tickets.

This is how it works:

1. You select the Allied Arts Member Agency(s) from whom you wish to receive tickets.
2. We notify the Member Arts Agencies that you selected.
3. The agencies will send you a gift certificate or voucher for the requested number of tickets.
4. You, then, will call the arts agency/ticket office to make specific reservations and seating choices (if applicable) to the events of your choice.

You should know that:
